Adžić is a family winery established in 1995. The first bottle was sold on the market that year. It was followed by the construction of a modern wine cellar built as part of the family house with the goal of offering the highest quality wines to the customers.

VINEYARDS

The vineyards are located in the villages of Hrnjevac, Venje and Mitrovac in the well-known Kutjevo region on the southern slopes of Krndija. The area is highly recognized for the quality of wines and takes pride in its eight hundred-year-old tradition in winegrowing. Today the family farms 8 hectares of its own vineyards, growing Graševina, Pinot Gris, Pinot Noir, Zweigelt, and Riesling, and contracts fruits from 2 additional hectares.

WINE MAKING

Antun has built his own cellar as part of the family house where wine matures in stainless steel and wooden barrels. All the grapes are fermented with native yeasts. Whites are vinified and aged in stainless steel and reds age in Slavonian oak barrels.



NOTES & PAIRINGS

A quality Graševina (Welschriesling) from Kutjevo in the heartland of Slavonia and one of the best wine-growing districts for Graševina. The wine is light, fresh and fruity. Enjoy it with grilled prawns, fish, cured meat and hard cheese.
